The purpose of a scholarship is to reduce the tuition fee of your course. If you are successful in receiving a scholarship the amount will be deducted just before you enrol.

Terms and Conditions

- 1) To be eligible for consideration for an international scholarship you must:
 - Have an offered place at your chosen course at London School of Business.
 - Must provide evidence of an overseas student for tuition fee purposes.
- 2) To be eligible for consideration for an EU scholarship, you must:
 - Have an offered place at your chosen course at London School of Business.
 - Must provide evidence of being an EU student for tuition fee purposes.
- 3) Your scholarship application must be sent separate from your application to study with London School of Business.
- 4) If you are sponsored by an employer, government or awarding body to pay for your tuition fees whether it is full time or part time, your application will not be considered.
- 5) You will only be eligible to apply for a scholarship once per academic year of a qualifying course February 2020/June 2020/October 2020.
- 6) You are only eligible to apply for a scholarship if you are starting your first year in February 2020/June 2020/October 2020. If you are leading into your second, third or fourth year your application will not be considered.
- 7) Unless you are a new international or EU student applying for your first year or you are an existing student at LSB and you are enrolling for your first year in a new course you will not be eligible to apply for a scholarship and your application will not be considered.
- 8) This scholarship application form is only for London School of Business courses.
- 9) The main purpose for a scholarship is a reduction from your tuition fee. If you are successful in your application the reduction will be made before you enrol.
- 10) The awarded amount from the scholarship is not transferable. If you choose to change the start date of your course or change your course your fee will not be transferred.
- 11) From the moment the application has been sent, the candidate will be informed about the decision 2 weeks after the submission.
- 12) The scholarship will be awarded to the applicant once they have accepted the offer and have met the criteria for their chosen course and once they are eligible to enrol.
- 13) Being awarded a scholarship is highly competitive therefore it is important that you spend enough time to prepare for your statements and ensure to refer to the criteria.

- 14) The school will hold the final decision in awarding the scholarship to the suitable student.
- 15) If you are successful in your application, there will be a 30% deduction from your tuition fee.
- 16) If you are successful in your application, we may ask you to appear online on our website and social media platforms for marketing and university success purposes. For example, by providing your photograph and profile they may be used to promote the school, the school's scholarship schemes and courses.
- 17) Your name, photograph and course name may used in the Scholarships Awards Celebration Programme.
- 18) In any case, if the student fails to complete the course and you wish to retake the course or undertake another course, you will not be eligible to apply for another scholarship.
- 19) If you choose to withdraw from your course and you still owe a proportion of your tuition fees to the school, your application for the scholarship will be withdrawn.
